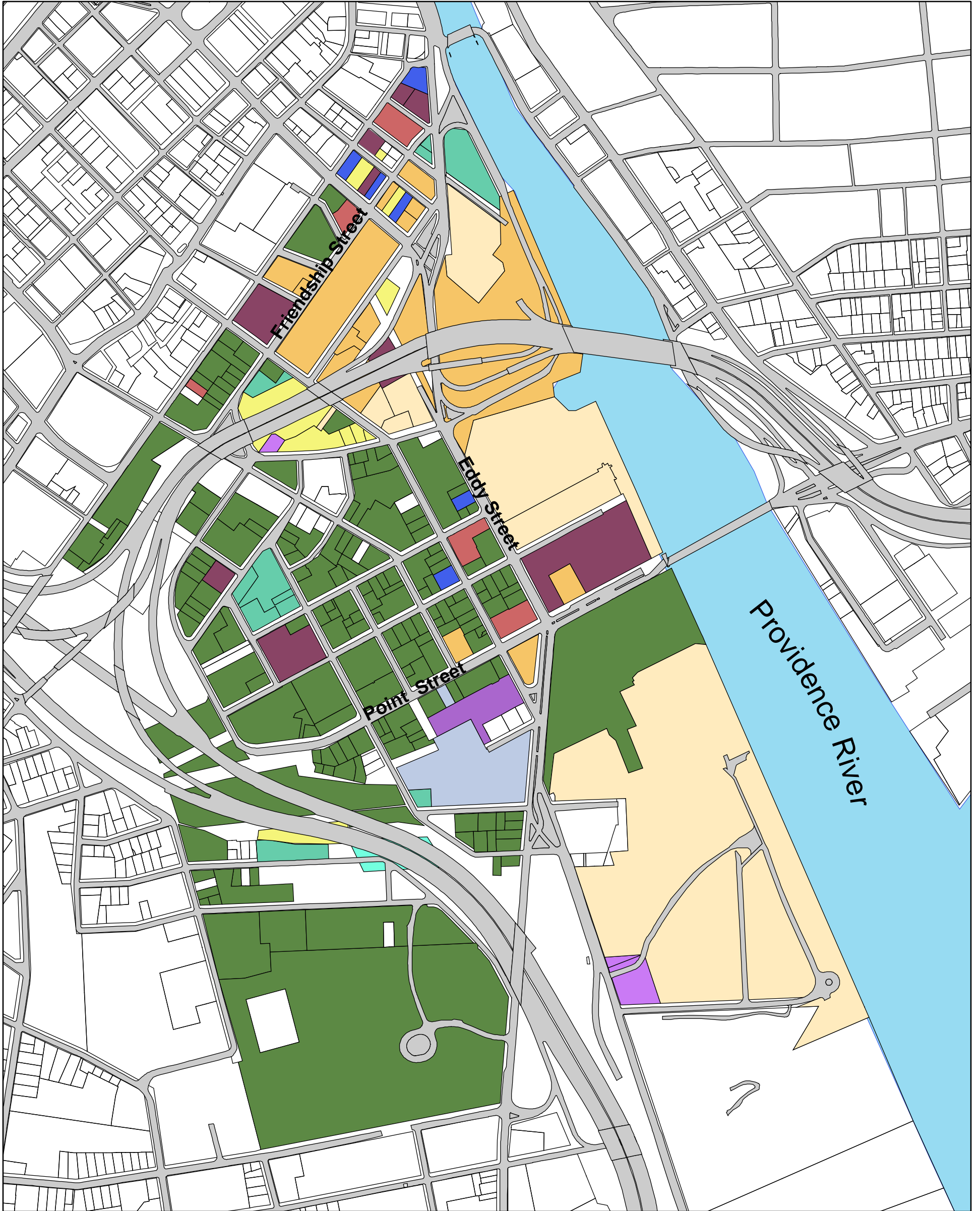












Land Use in 1889
