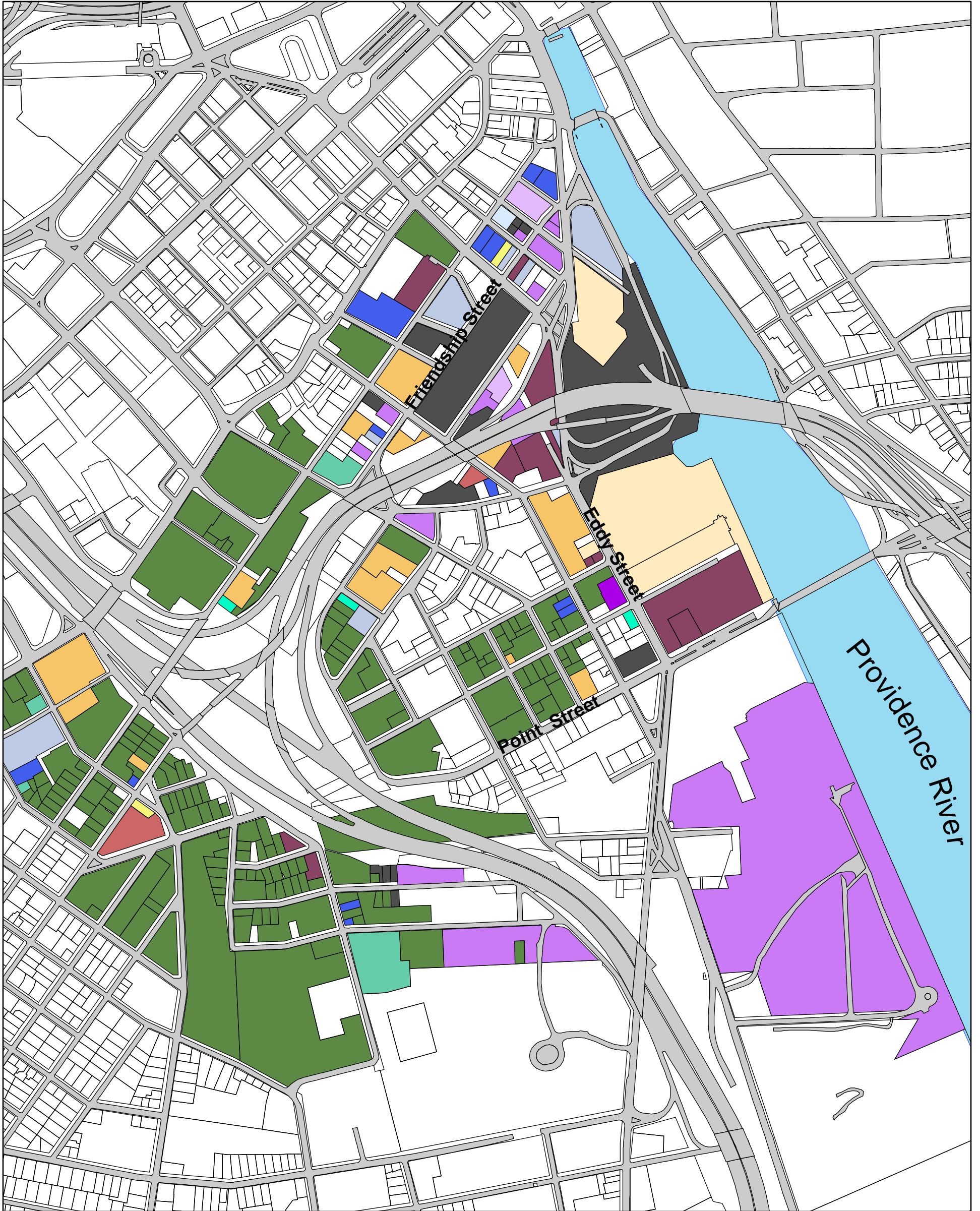














Land Use in 1920
